

1. BRUSSELS | MAY 26 - 28

Arrival: June 9/ / Departure: June 12 | 11:30am




In Lisbon, BusinessRail participants will get to fully experience the culture, history, flavours and dynamic of the city that had great impact on the Discoveries of the 15th century.
